Re: Kingston Park Reserve: *Resumption of progress*

As you are aware we held a successful public forum of approximately 150 local residents on 15 May, 2018 at the Brighton and Seacliff Yacht Club. Its primary objective was to provide residents of Marino, Kingston Park and Seacliff with an understanding of the status and progress of plans associated with the Reserve and to elicit their responses to those plans. (See attached copy of our letter 21May 2018)

The Association met with Pam Jackson and Rajiv Mouveri, soon after the Forum to frame a detailed response on the issues raised. This was a very fruitful meeting, unfortunately we were unable to capitalise on the momentum achieved, due to the Section 23 Challenge in the SA Supreme Court. As a result all works in the reserve were put on hold including essential maintenance and reinstatements following the path work.

We note that the Section 23 Challenge has been settled; as a result we seek clarity on:

1. *When will the Post Path reinstatement works, be confirmed, and what is the time-line for these works? E.g. reinstatement and protection of the grassed area south of the car park and north of the spring outlet*
2. *Will Council develop a program for further short/medium term enhancements we have discussed with Rajiv Mouveri?(see below)*
3. *Outcomes of the Indigenous Heritage review process*
4. *When will the Master Plan review process be re-activated?*

There are several short term enhancements (Item 2 above) which we hope will be progressed (See latest issues Log)

- Temporary Cafe provisions pending the permanent solution
- Re-installation of seating
- Temporary Car park improvements including permanent fencing the Caravan park boundary
- Reinstatement of the barriers to cars beyond the car park to the south

We look forward to your response on these important matters.
